With 150 million orphaned children around the world, we are well aware that we will not be able to welcome all of them into our programs, and so it is evident that we can have a larger global impact if we place more emphasis on helping community-based organizations restructure their own systems and processes to better reflect more modern orphan-care techniques, and also by providing capacity building support that assists organizations in things like admin, media, data measurement, fundraising, and things of this nature, which will allow them to focus on their own programs, give them access to resources that they might not have had otherwise, and provide tools and expertise that lead to greater growth.

We have already started experimenting with some of these tactics and are excited to share more as they become ingrained in our overall support structure.


